Please join us for our October Virtual Branch Meeting. We will receive a presentation about UT Austin construction updates from Director Jim Shackelford and Associate Director Michael Uyeda, who work at UT Austin Capital Planning.

MEET THE SPEAKERS =

James is a graduate of the University of Texas at Austin School of Architecture with over 41 years of professional experience. From 1980 to 2004 Jim was engaged in private practice in Austin as either a Project Architect, Construction Administrator, Project Manager or Principal. In 2017, Jim was appointed as the Director of the Capital Planning and Construction office at the University of Texas at Austin, overseeing a portfolio of 13 active projects totaling over \$800M. He continues in that role today.

During Jim's tenure with the University of Texas, he has supervised the design and construction of over 7.5 million Gross Square Feet of new and renovated space, with a total value in excess of \$3.5 billion.






