Honorary membership may be granted to individuals who have distinguished themselves by meritorious service in the furtherance of Rotary ideals.

No individual should be told he or she is being considered for Rotary membership. Each proposal is reviewed by the Membership Committee and submitted with a recommendation to the Board of Directors. If approved, the prospective member is informed of the proposal by the Rotary Information Committee and told of the privileges and responsibilities of membership. With his or her permission, the name and classification of the proposed is published twice in COGS. Without objection from the membership and upon payment of an admission fee, he or she becomes a Grants Pass Rotarian.
