

## Want Lower Pump Prices? Use More Ethanol

A new Morning Consult survey finds strong support among registered voters for expanding the use of renewable fuels, like ethanol, to cut fuel prices. Nearly three in four voters support increasing sales of the E15 ethanol blend, and more than two-thirds believe automakers should be incentivized to make more flex-fuel vehicles. ### Ethanol Saves Drivers Money at the Pump

The common 10% ethanol blend of fuel (often labeled as E10) currently saves drivers nearly 25 cents for <u>every gallon of gas</u> they purchase, and being homegrown, ethanol can bolster our energy security as it is <u>better insulated from price impacts</u> of geopolitical events than gasoline.
