Position Overview:

We are seeking qualified candidates, 18 years of age or older, to join our summer staff from June 10th-August 14th, 2022. Summer Staff will provide leadership for our eight week Day Camp program as well as other weekday and weekend programming for groups. The ideal candidate is a person who has experience working with kids, knows how to interact with them appropriately, and puts them first; who has a sense of creativity and flexibility; has a desire to learn and grow in community; a willingness to try new things and learn to lead them; and an openness to all tasks necessary to ensure our guests have an amazing and hospitable time. Since Koinonia is a Lutheran outdoor ministry, we are looking for someone who has a background in the church or a respect for faith and other backgrounds and is open to participating in the community here.

General Job Duties:

Hospitality -

Ensure that all guests feel welcome at Koinonia.

Be present at most weekday and weekend retreats and programs, working with groups and individuals.

Go the extra mile to ensure all our guests feel welcome and special while here.

Food service, washing dishes, and general cleaning.

Programming -

Lead groups and individuals in games, hiking, crafts, music, boating, service projects, bonfires, hayrides, and swimming.

Facilities -

Set up cabins and conference center to meet all programming needs.

Clean cabins and conference center after groups stay.

Maintenance -

Help clean up kitchen after food service.

Assist maintenance director in projects throughout the week.

Various necessary jobs as they arise in agreement with Executive Director and/or Program Director.

Has the ability to think critically and deal well with an ever changing, adaptive environment.

Summer Staff Agreement

Living and working in Koinonia as a member of the summer staff offers a fun and unique experience! The staff at Koinonia will spend the summer impacting the lives of the greater community through Day Camp, weekend retreats, and other ministry opportunities, all while living in community with one another.

As an applicant, we ask that you prayerfully consider the following expectations of our Summer Staff:

- The staff is called to live out the mission of Koinonia at all times, whether working within our property or outside in the community.
- During Camp, guests come first. Staff should be engaged, loving, and patient with ALL campers. When working with guests, staff is expected to be energetic, helpful, and kind.
- Summer Staff will show respect for each other's personal privacy and property, as they live together in close quarters.
- No summer staff may have alcohol on site. Staff over the age of 21 may consume alcohol off-site, on days off, in moderation. The use of drugs is prohibited. Drug screenings may be issued if drug use is suspected. Tobacco products may be consumed in designated areas and not during the regular work-day.
- All staff understands that they may be occasionally asked to help with tasks outside their job description that help support the ministry of Koinonia.
- Koinonia has a policy of ZERO TOLERANCE FOR ABUSE and takes all allegations of abuse seriously. Furthermore, Koinonia cooperates fully with the authorities to investigate all cases of alleged abuse. Abuse of any kind is grounds for immediate dismissal from employment, and possible criminal charges.
