



# BBTCAC Artists Juried Exhibition “Water/Ways”

January 2021

*In connection with the Wilcox Area Chamber of Commerce’s Smithsonian Water/Ways Exhibition, Black Belt Treasures Cultural Arts Center is sponsoring a juried art exhibition in the month of January, with \$1000 in prizes. The theme for this exhibition is Black Belt Water/Ways – all works should be inspired by the water that runs through our beautiful region. A Reception and Awards Ceremony will be held on Thursday, January 20, in conjunction with a BBTCAC Membership Guild event. The exhibition will remain on view through the February 12.*

## Eligibility

Open to all current BBTCAC artists (or artists living in the Black Belt Region, willing to become a BBTCAC Artist). All entries must be original artworks completed within the last five years. If work is inspired from photographs, all entries should be from your own photograph(s) or have the photographers’ permission to use their work. A completed Artwork Label (see *Application*) must be securely attached to the back of each entry for identification.

## Stipulations and Prizes

Oil, acrylic, watercolor, pen and ink, pencil, pastel, conte crayons, markers, mixed media, charcoal paintings, and three-dimensional artworks will be accepted.

*Maximum finished (framed) dimensions for ALL works (2D & 3D) must be no larger than 36” by 36”.*

*All entries must be display ready: framed or gallery wrapped, and READY for hanging.*

BBTCAC will respect the Juror’s recommendation on awards and reserves the right to not award all prizes if the theme, guidelines, number of submissions, or quality is not met. In addition, a **People’s Choice Award** will be announced during the reception on January 20th. Prize Money will be a “split the pot” cash award, dependent on number of votes collected during the duration of the exhibition (at \$1 per vote).

## Sale of Art

All works submitted must be available for sale. BBTCAC’s standard 70/30 commission rate will apply to all sales.

## Juror | Martha Lockett | Dallas County, Alabama

*For the last two decades, Martha Lockett has served as a leader in the fight for positive change across Alabama’s Black Belt region and Dallas County, with a focus on arts education and creative tourism. Lockett served as the first Executive Director of Arts Revive in Selma from 2012 until her retirement in 2017 and assisted in their formation since its conception. While there, Lockett lead Arts Revive through a period of growth and renovation, expansion of the properties and programs, and organization of multiple programs, exhibitions, and events – including the Spider Martin exhibition, the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Civil Rights March exhibition and programs, and the organization and management of each year’s Tale Tellin’ Festival. Prior to her involvement with Arts Revive, Lockett served as the Arts in Education Coordinator for Selma City School District; was the Co-Founder of the Alabama Institute for Education in the Arts; served as Arts Education Specialist for the Alabama State Department of Education; and served on the Alabama Music Educators Association Board.*
