

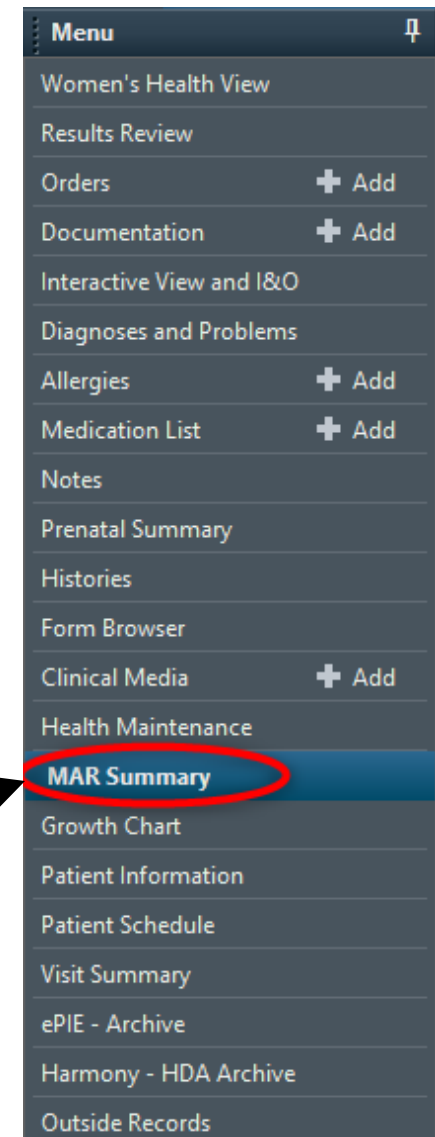
Navigating the MAR

June 30, 2021

To improve communication about medication administration by nurses for providers, this tool was created to assist providers in accessing and navigating the **medication administration record (MAR) Summary**.

In the Dark Menu, select the “MAR Summary” tab. This will take you to the medication administration record.

The MAR Summary is condensed and allows a concise view of the medication administration record over an extended range of time.

If a longer time range than the days shown is desired for review, then right click the grey bar at the top of the summary to change the time range

Hovering cursor over medication will cause popup with more information on medication order to appear



Order Info

If an "Order Info" button appears, clicking it will allow you to view all order information, including details, history, and comments. If no order button appears, right click medication name, and select "order info." This will allow you to access the same information




