The latest earthquake in Haiti has affected our friends at St. Paul's Episcopal Day School in the southern peninsula just outside of Les Cayes. Within the administration and staff, 27 of them have realized damage to their home and 3 of their homes were completely destroyed. Protection from the elements is essential and food and water is hard to come by. The school building is strong and received no damage but the cinder block fence protecting the school grounds was severely damaged and will need to be replaced.
