



## **Global Day of Action for Climate Justice on 6th November**

### **Useful info**

#### **What to bring:**

Waterproof clothing

Wear shoes that are comfortable and easy to walk in

If you are bringing young children, you may want to bring a buggy/scooter or bike to make it easy for them to cover the distance of the march

Bring water and snacks as you may be out for longer than you anticipate

Feel free to join in with singing or chanting, or not. There's no right or wrong way to act on a protest march. Some people like to be noisy and/or colourful.

Others may want to walk quietly. You can bring a banner, placard, flag etc and shakers, whistles to make a noise but equally you don't have to. Your presence is what's important.

There is no legal requirement to wear a face mask outdoors, but you may choose to do so. You may also wish to bring gloves and hand sanitiser. There is no legal requirement to socially distance from other people but the march will be spaced out to allow for distancing if you wish.

### **Your rights**

If you need to leave the march to go to the toilet or for any other reason you have the right to do so and to return to the march

It is your right to take part in peaceful protest. You do not have to chat with police officers unless you want to and it is your right to answer no comment to any questions

At most large protests, Legal Observers will be present. You can spot them wearing high-vis jackets that often say "Legal Observer". They are volunteers who are there to monitor police, and counter any intimidation or unlawful behaviour protesters might face. They are independent from both the protest and the police, and may be able to provide support or advice if you need it.
